Subject: - Grant of Conditional permission to D.M.M Ayurved Mahavidyalaya Yavatmal, Shiavji Nagar, Arni Road, Dist. Yavatmal-445001, Maharashtra (Inst. ID AYU0176) for intake capacity with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats and (ii) Rog Nidan evum Vikriti Vigyan-03 seats (iii) Shalya Tantra -06 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 and issuance of Letter of Permission to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely Shalakaya tantra with 06 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2024-25-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM ACT 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. I am to refer to your application vide **Ref. No. vide ref. no. 2411 dated 14.09.2023**, on the subject cited above and to verify the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff and other facilities available at your college namely **D.M.M Ayurved Mahavidyalaya Yavatmal, Shiavji Nagar, Arni Road, Dist. Yavatmal-445001, Maharashtra (Inst. ID AYU0176)**, your college was visited on **27.12.2023 & 28.12.2023** for the issuance of LOI to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely **Shalakaya tantra with 06 seats from the academic session 2024-25** and the same has been issued to your college vide letter of even no. dated **19.02.2024** to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely **Shalakaya tantra with 06 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2024-25**.
2. Thereafter, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) had carried out an inspection of the college again on **14.03.2024 & 15.03.2024 through Hybrid mode** to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities available as a part of annual visitation for issuance of conditional permission for intake capacity **60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats and (ii) Rog Nidan evum Vikriti Vigyan-03 seats (iii) Shalya Tantra -06 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25** and for issuance of Letter of Permission to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely **Shalakaya tantra with 06 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2024-25**.
3. Further, in view of above assessment report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely "the Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020. **On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcoming/defect have been observed-**

- a) Availability of teaching staff is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{29}{30} \times 100\% = 96.6\%$.

- Thereafter, the assessment report was placed in the **90th Board Meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **17.05.2024**. The Board observed that the college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria; However, the college is fulfilling the criteria required for issuance of permission as per the Regulation 3 (3) of MSR 2016. Hence, the Board decided that the college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for grant of conditional Permission with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats and (ii) Rog Nidan evum Vikriti Vigyan-03 seats (iii) Shalya Tantra -06 seats for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and issuance of letter of Permission to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely Shalakaya tantra with 06 seats under section 29 of NCISM ACT 2020 from academic session 2024-25.
- Further, in accordance of the regulation 6 (2) (i) of "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019 vide letter of even no. dated 03.06.2024 a letter was sent to you to furnish fixed security deposit worth **Rupees 50 lakhs** for a period of three years in favor of National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine. In response of the same your college has furnished the fixed security deposit in favor of the National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine of **rupees 50 lakhs** through online payment mode **RTGS Ref no. BICZON24166859307** dated 14.06.2024 Bank of India and informed the same vide letter ref. No. **DMMAMY/LOP-FSD/333/24** dated 14.06.2024 by an email dated 14.06.2024.
- Therefore, Grant of Conditional Permission is issued to **D.M.M Ayurved Mahavidyalaya Yavatmal, Shiavji Nagar, Arni Road, Dist. Yavatmal-445001, Maharashtra (Inst. ID AYU0176)** for intake capacity with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats and (ii) Rog Nidan evum Vikriti Vigyan-03 seats (iii) Shalya Tantra -06 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 and Letter of Permission (LOP) is issued to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely Shalakaya tantra with 06 seats from the academic session 2024-25 under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, subject to following conditions:
- It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 21 seats in 04 PG Courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply**

with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
9. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
11. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2024 and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2025-26: -**
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
 - All the requirements of minimum standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in MES (Assessment & Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016
 - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
 - The shortcoming mentioned in point no 3.**
12. This permission **for to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely Shalakaya tantra with 06 seats from the academic session 2024-25** as stated above for the first admitted batch of 2024-25 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against these courses appear for the first final examination of the said courses and at that time, the College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 35 of the NCISM Act 2020.
13. **The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.**

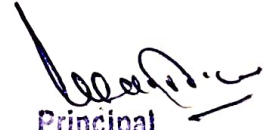
